

#### **4 Clerk's/Chairman's report**

Field adjacent A14/A10 - letter from SCDC:

"After the reconstruction works at the Milton interchange were completed Balfour Beatty were preparing to undergo another project for Cambridge City Council involving the building of a new bridge over the river Cam in the City. They were then going to use all the road planings, hardcore etc. for that project and move to a new site offered by the City Council. This should all have happened by early October 2006. Unfortunately the City Council are still deliberating as to the building of this new bridge.

Balfour Beatty have decided to put the sale of these road planings on the open market and are quite confident that they will be sold within the next 7 days. In that light I have given them 28 days from the date of this letter (11 Jan), to clear the site and revert it to its former state."

Chairman, RTS and clerk met with January's. The land is still owned Mrs Turner and Mrs Wilson. Turnstone Ltd have first option on the purchase of the site. January's are suggesting a hotel and car retail showroom for the site (if Green Belt protection is removed).

#### Crime
