To all users of Milton Community Centre

As you are probably aware, we have been planning a major refurbishment of the Community Centre for a number of years and I am pleased to say that the building work should commence at the beginning of August.

As with all building work, there is bound to be some disruption and until the work actually starts, it is difficult to say how each of you will be affected, but in order to keep you in the picture, I have detailed below certain points that may be relevant to you.

- The refurbishment includes replacing the metal cladding to the low level at the front of the building with brickwork, new changing rooms, toilets, office and entrance hall, + replacing mechanical and electrical services.
- The main hall, store cupboard, downstairs lounge, kitchen and both rooms upstairs will not be affected.
- It is envisaged that initially the changing rooms will be unavailable and the ladies loo will be temporarily located (probably into where my office is at present)
- When the work is carried out on the entrance hall, it will be necessary to create a temporary entrance, which will be suitable for disabled, pushchairs etc.

The Community Centre will remain operational throughout the building work and we will ensure that toilet facilities (ladies, gents and disabled/baby changing) will be available. All being well, the work is expected to be finished by the end of October 2010.

Please feel free to contact me if you have any queries or concerns. Although I appreciate there may be a certain amount of inconvenience, I am sure you will agree that we will all benefit from the improved facilities in the long run.
