Mr. J. S. Prior was elected as one Manager of the School
and on the Proposition of Mr. Nelson seconded by Mr.
E. T. Carlton Mr Jas. Carlton was elected as another
Manager - and it was understood these two members
were only appointed in case of necessity.
- (2) on the Proposition of Mr. Edmunds seconded by Mr.
Goodwin it was resolved that the District Council
should be asked to clean out the Main drain from
the Pond to Mr. Gibb's - as it was considered a serious
nuisance.
- (3). on the Proposition of Mr. Edmunds seconded by Mr. Carlton
it was resolved that the emergency drain from the
Pond down the Jen. Road be seen after also.
- (4). on the Proposition of Mr. Edmunds seconded by Mr.
Soden it was resolved that the District Council
be informed that Pipes are being placed near the
Merton Road on the Laversage Farm and nearer the
Parish of Merton and reminding the Council of
Mr. Young's statement that the Laversage would be
300 yards from the Road at the nearest point
and asking for an assurance in this respect as
the Farm has been considered a nuisance recently
