

Meeting on March 1<sup>st</sup> 1912

Present Chairman: The Rev Canon Evans,

J. E. Honey objected to the answers sent to the Local Government Board, in reply to the letter of October 31<sup>st</sup> 1911, on the ground that the answers were not those agreed to at a meeting of the Parish Council called for that purpose on November 17<sup>th</sup> 1911

Proposed by G. Wilson and seconded by A. L. Humphreys that Ernest Carlton, Charles Day, Edward Wilkin, and Arthur Slack be nominated for the office of Parish Constables for the ensuing year - Carried

Proposed by E. S. Robinson, seconded by W. J. Wilson and carried, that the Overseers be authorized to incur any reasonable expenses in obtaining a list of property from the Overseers of Chesterton for the making out of a Supplemental Valuation List containing the assessments of the added area conferred on the Parish by the Local Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation Act 1911

The Chairman produced a certificate of analysis of water from the Parish Dumps which was considered satisfactory

A discussion was raised on the bad state of the Bankers Ditch and it was proposed by F. H. Robinson seconded by G. Wilson and carried, that the Clerk write to the Chesterton Rural District Council pointing out the state of the ditch and asking them to take

The matter in hand as soon as possible.
