

A Parish Meeting held on March 14th 1913 for the purpose of electing Parish councillors for the ensuing three years 38 electors being present. Chairman Rev. Canon G. W. Evans.

Mr G. Wilson proposed and A. L. Humphreys seconded that only the business of election of Parish councillors be taken which on being put to the meeting was carried unanimously.

The chairman then asked for nomination papers, 14 papers being handed in.

All the nomination papers were valid.
