Meeting held on May 23rd 1913
 E. E. Mello, G. Wilson, J. Carlton, W. Wilkin
 B. Pearson, A. B. Jacobs, F. W. Williams.

The clerk reported that Mr J. E. Hony
 declined the chairmanship.
 Mr G. Wilson then took the chair for the evening.

Resolved, on the proposition of B. Pearson sec-
 by F. W. Williams that Mr E. E. Mello be
 chairman of the council.

Minutes of last meeting were read and
 confirmed.

The clerk reported that the new Justice Board
 had been erected on land in the centre of
 the village and that the owner of the land
 Mr F. Wilson stipulated that £16 per annum
 should be paid as rent for the land on
 which the Board stands.

W. Wilkin proposed A. B. Jacobs seconded that
 Mr Wilson be offered 11- per annum as rent.
 An amendment was proposed by G. Wilson seconded
 by J. Carlton that Mr F. Wilson be paid the
 rent he asked viz - £16 per annum.

On the amendment being put there voted, for the
 amendment G. Wilson & J. Carlton, Against
 W. Wilkin & A. B. Jacobs. The Chairman then
 voted for and declared the amendment
 carried. B. Pearson & F. W. Williams did not
 vote.

It was resolved that the Clerk have the custody of the Parish Award and other documents relating to the Parish.

Proposed by B Pearson seconded by W. Wilkin that steps be taken to investigate the whereabouts of all Parish property, and that the Clerk write to the Local Government Board to enquire whether property formerly owned and managed by the Parish authorities, and of which no evidence can be found of rent having been received by the Parish for a number of years, can now be claimed by the Council.

On the proposition being put there voted for B Pearson, A B Jacobs, W. Wilkin & W. Williams. The Chairman and G Wilson did not vote. The proposition was therefore declared carried.
