

Meeting of Parish Council held on September 24th
1913

The minutes of meeting on May 23rd were read and signed.

A letter was read in answer to one sent by the clerk to the Local Government Board, asking for legal advice respecting the leasing of Parish property in the village.

The Local Government Board in their reply stated that "advice could be given as to the legal aspect of the matter and suggested that a solicitor be consulted, when the facts could be placed before him personally. After some discussion, B. Pearson proposed and F. W. Williams seconded, that Mr. S. R. Ginn be asked to give his ruling on the question, and that 2 members of the Council wait upon him to state the facts. It was finally decided that the Chairman and F. W. Williams be the members appointed for that purpose.

Agreed that the tenants of the Parish Banters be given notice to quit by the clerk with a view to placing the ~~tenancies~~ tenancies on a proper footing with agreement etc
