

Meeting on March 27th 1914

Present

On item on the agenda re waterbrough in
watercourse near Baitsbite B. Pearson proposed
G. Wilson seconded, that a sub-committee be formed
to inspect the brough, consisting of the Chairman
B. Pearson and G. Wilson with power to act.
This was agreed to unanimously.

Proposed by A. B. Jacobs that a fence be
erected in the place of the gate as at present,
on the north side of the bank adjoining the Fen
Road thus preventing the bank, now in the
occupation of A. Hall's, being used as a roadway.
This proposition was seconded by W. Wilkin and
carried unanimously.

Agreed, that the Clerk be instructed to write
to the District Surveyor Mr. J. Dunn calling his
attention to the following matters and asking
him to attend to them as soon as convenient

- 1 A watercourse, adjoining Mr. Green's land on
Cambridge Road and the Meseway, which
badly needs cleaning out.

- 2 The bad condition of Rutt Lane, where the
water remaining from the road has no means of
getting away except by a deep gutter cut
through the path, which is very dangerous at
night.

- 3 The condition of the road near Manor Farm
where after a heavy rain the water collects in
a big pool causing considerable inconvenience to
residents of the houses adjoining the road.
