

Annual meeting of Parish Council held
on April 21st 1914

Present

F. W. Williams, B. Pearson, G. Wilson, W. Wilkin
J. Barton, E. S. Mills

Proposed by F. W. Williams seconded by J. Barton
and carried that G. Wilson take the chair pro tem.

Proposed by B. Pearson seconded by F. W. Williams
that E. S. Mills be chairman for the year
ensuing. This was carried unanimously.

Minutes of meeting on March 27th were read
and confirmed and signed.

It was voted on the proposition of G. Wilson
seconded by W. Wilkin that E. S. Mills be
one Overseer and on the proposition of B. Pearson
seconded by J. Barton that F. W. Williams
be the other Overseer.

It was resolved on the proposition of G. Wilson
seconded by B. Pearson that B. Shipp be
reappointed waterman at the same salary viz:-
13/- per quarter.

An estimate of £5-10-0 for a new water trough
on the Haling-way in Mutton Fen was considered
and as the price seemed rather high in the
opinion of the Council, W. Wilkin proposed
and G. Wilson seconded that the Clerk be
instructed to write to A. D. Abraham of Lymington
who sent in the estimate, and inform him that

if he could do the work for £5 he would do the work as soon as possible.

A letter was read from Sandbeach Parish Council asking the Milton Council to cooperate with them in a scheme for the destruction of sparrows. After some discussion the Clerk was instructed to write and inform the Sandbeach Council that the Milton Council would like something more definite as to what was meant to be done before being able to join in any scheme of the kind named.
