It was therefore proposed by W Pearson seconded  
 by W Wilkin and carried that F W Williams  
 be a representative trustee.

It was resolved that the Clerk write to the  
 Great Eastern Railway Company calling  
 their attention to the Railway's drains  
 being allowed to grow up and asking them  
 to do something in the matter.

It was resolved that the District Councillor  
 for the Parish be asked to call the attention  
 of the District Council to bad condition of  
 the culvert under the Iron Road and asking  
 them to repair it.
