

A Meeting held on September 21st 1917

A circular was received from the Chesterton Rural District Council asking the Sanial Council to undertake the destruction of Rats and Sparrows for which the District Council would pay the following amounts: Rats 1st each Old Sparrows 4th a dozen young Sparrows 3rd a dozen Sparrows eggs 2nd a dozen.

On the proposition of G Wilson seconded by B Pearson the scheme was adopted. The Council also considered a letter from the Rural District Council Re Housing of the Working Classes at the conclusion of the war. After some discussion it was agreed that 12 houses be asked for and the Clerk was instructed to fill up the form to that effect.
