15 electors being present

Proposed by A B Jacobs seconded by A Butcher
that G H Pearson take the chair

8 nominations were handed in containing the
following names Alfred Isaac Butcher, James Carlton
Charles Day, Simon Easop, Arthur Boston Jacobs
Ernest Edward Mills, Bertram Pearson, George Wilson

No candidate being withdrawn a show of hands
was taken and votes were given as follows: -

A J Butcher	14	votes
James Carlton	3	
Charles Day	14	
Simon Easop	15	
Arthur Boston Jacobs	15	
Ernest Edward Mills	7	
Bertram Pearson	14	
George Wilson	11	

The Chairman put the question as to a poll being
demanded which was done by 2 electors.

As these were not sufficient the Chairman declared
the 7 highest duly elected
