

The Annual meeting of Parish Council held
April 15th 1919

Present

It was agreed on the proposition of S Easy seconded
by A Butcher that G B Jacobs be Chairman

It was agreed on the proposition of G Wilson
seconded B Pearson that J Carlton be
vice-chairman.

In the absence of the Chairman the vice chairman
took the chair.

On the proposition of G Wilson seconded by B Pearson
it was agreed that Mr to Hopkins be one
overseer and on the proposition of G Wilson
seconded by S Easy it was agreed that
Mr to Goodin be the other overseer

It was agreed on the proposition of G Wilson seconded
by S Easy that G B Pearson be reappointed
Assistant Overseer at a salary of £30 per annum

It was agreed on the proposition of L Wilson seconded by A Butcher that B Shiff be reappointed waterman and it was agreed on the proposition of J Gray seconded by B Pearson that the salary for the work be 1/6 per week instead of 1/- as formerly. The increased pay to take effect as from March 25th 1919.

A circular was read re Housing of the working classes Act explaining the formation of Public Utility Societies to carry out any scheme of building which might be adopted in the Parish. The clerk was instructed to find out who was Housing Commissioner for district and if necessary a Parish meeting could be called to have the scheme explained.

B Pearson proposed and J Gray seconded that the clerk write to the Secretary of the Bucks Education Committee pointing out the bad condition of the school playground and asking that the matter be attended to at once and also to call his attention to the sanitary arrangements as being far from satisfactory.

The clerk was also instructed to enquire as to the terms on which a representative of the Council is appointed as manager of the schools and when the term of office expires.

The clerk was instructed to ask Messrs Sack of Cottenham to repair the village pump

It was agreed on the proposition of B. Teanson seconded by S. Barry that a Danish meeting be called at an early date, to consider the question of a War Memorial for the Danish.

A Danish meeting held on May 8th 1919
This meeting was called owing to the disagreement of a committee appointed at a public meeting called for the purpose of considering the erection of some form of memorial to those who have lost their lives in the war.

Mr A. B. Jacobs Chairman of the Danish Council took the Chair.

Resolved on the proposition of B. Teanson seconded by A. S. Keech that a monument be erected in the village as a memorial to the dead.

Resolved on the proposition of W. Dunn seconded by B. Teanson that a committee be nominated for the purpose of carrying out the wishes of meeting.

Resolved on the proposition of J. E. Honey seconded by B. Teanson that the committee consist of 5 persons
