A letter was read from the Secretary Camba
Education Committee Austin Neen Esq.
disclaiming any liability for the repair of
the Fawcett School playground and
stating that the responsibility for the playground
lay with the Managers of the School.

It was proposed by B. Pearson seconded by
J. Easy and carried that the managers
be written to calling their attention to the
state of the playground and also pointing
out that the sanitary arrangements at
the school are far from satisfactory.

It was agreed that Lacks of Tottenham
be written to asking them to repair the
Fawcett pumps as requested within one week
from date of letter and should this not
be done to ask G. Wilson to do the
work.

Re "Housing of the Working Classes" a circular
was read from the Housing Committee
of the C.R.D.C. asking the Council
to select suitable sites for the erection
