

A meeting held on Sept 26th 1919

Present Mr A B Jacobs Chairman, L Wilson J Bayly
 B Day B Pearson A J Butcher.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson
 seconded by J Bayly that A B Jacobs
 be the Parish Council representative school
 manager.

It was agreed that the Parish Centre be
 repaired and B Butcher of States beach
 be asked to undertake the work.
 Messrs L Wilson J Bayly & B Pearson were
 appointed as a committee to supervise the work.

Agreed that the Clerk obtain further information
 as to the powers of the Parish Council to
 build a Public Hall.

A circular was read from the Ministry of
 Health pointing out that under the provisions of
 the Land Settlement (Facilities) Act 1919 which
 came into operation on 19th August 1919, it is
 the statutory duty of Parish Councils to provide
 allotments to meet the demand from residents
 in the Parish. After some discussion it was
 agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded
 by A J Butcher that the Clerk be instructed
 to post notices inviting applications for
 allotments.

A letter was read from Mrs J Dunn offering

the Council some emergency coal for distribution in an emergency.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson that the offer be accepted and a committee consisting of A Dutcher, G Day & Bang and B Pearson was appointed to make the necessary arrangements and superintend the distribution of the coal.
