

A meeting on November 7th 1919

Present

A Receipt was signed calling on the Overseers for the sum of £40 pounds in payment for emergency coal.

It was agreed that for convenience Mr A Day to Day and The Chairman be authorized to sign cheques in payment for coal.

A letter was read from the Hamto County Council addressed to the Overseers asking them to send a copy of the present Valuation List together with an expression of opinion as to whether any items were assessed too high or too low. After some discussion it was agreed that Mr Tolson be instructed to see the County Council and ask what is really wanted, and a meeting of the Parish Council with the Overseers, be called to consider the matter.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Easy that the Parish Council apply to Hamto County Council asking for their assistance in hiring 5 acres of land conveniently situated in the Parish for the purpose of letting out in allotments.

It was agreed on the proposition of G Wilson
seconded by B Gearson that the Clerk
see G Boulton and ask him to put a
new waterbrough at the village pump

present assessments are sufficiently high
and no alteration is needed."
