The minutes of meeting on Sept 1st 1920 were read and signed.

In the absence of the Chairman Mr J Carleton the vice-chairman took the chair.

Letters were read from 4 persons making an application for 4 acres of land as allotments

Proposed by B Pearson seconded by J Carleton and carried that the Clerk be instructed to make an application under the Land Settlement (Facilities) Act 1918 to the Cambo County Council for 10 acres of land to let out as Allotments

At this point the Chairman arrived and took the Chair.

Proposed by B Pearson seconded by A Dutcher that the Clerk be instructed to write to the Chesterton Rural Council asking them to fill in the pond in the centre of the village or failing that to put it in sanitary condition.

An amendment was proposed by G Wilson seconded by J Carleton that the pond be left as it is. The voting resulted in there being two for the amendment and two for the proposition.

The Chairman then voted for proposition which was therefore carried.
