were read and signed.

After hearing a report from the Clerk as to the
cost of building a room in which to hold the
meetings of the Council and also for the use of the
Parish generally it was unanimously agreed on
the proposition of G. H. Pearson seconded by S. Easy
that the offer of G. H. Pearson to build a room be
accepted and that the Council agree to pay a rent
on the basis of 5 per cent per annum on the cost
of building the room but not exceeding £100 a year.

It was resolved on the proposition of G. Wilson
seconded by S. Easy that the room be leased
for 7 years.
