

At a Parish Council meeting held on June 17th 1921 in the Parish Council room the following gentlemen were present

The Chairman Mr A D Jacobs Messrs G Wilson
S Bony J Carlton A J Butler and
D Pearson.

The Minutes of previous meeting were read approved and signed by the Chairman

After receiving a report from the Clerk as to cost of the new Council room it was resolved on the proposition of D Pearson seconded by G Wilson that the room be hired on a lease for 7 years at a rental of Four pounds per annum, the Council agreeing to pay half the cost of the lease. It was also agreed that the tenancy commence on June 24th 1921 and that the rent be paid annually on that date in any year.

It was agreed on the proposition of G Wilson seconded by S Bony that the room be let to any person requiring it on application to the Clerk and that no charge be made for the hire of the room but any person using the room be liable for the cost of sweeping and cleaning and also must pay the caretaker for any fuel or oil used in the room during their occupation of same.

It was agreed that Mrs J Butler be the caretaker without payment from the Council as her services will be paid for by the persons hiring the room.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A Butcher that G Wilson and S Bay be appointed as the Council Room committee with power to act

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A Butcher that the Clerk write to the County Education Secretary offering ~~him~~ him the use of the Council room for any purpose connected with Education.

In the absence of the Chairman Mr J Carlton vice chairman presided
It was agreed that in consequence of the legal charges which would be incurred in the preparation of a lease for the new Council Room and agreement from year to year be prepared.

A list of names of the applicants for the new houses six in number ~~to~~ was sent by the Clerk to the C.R.D.C. Housing Committee, for the Parish Council's consideration and asking the Council to choose the most suitable among them.

The following persons (after a discussion on their merits and demerits had taken place) were recommended as the most suitable tenants
