

The Parish Meeting for the election of Parish Councillors was held in the schoolroom on March 13th 1922 at 7 o'clock in the evening.

Proposed by S Gray, seconded by J Gregg and carried unanimously that Mr G H Pearson be Chairman of the meeting.

The Chair was taken at 7-15 pm.

Eleven nominations were handed in for seven seats, consisting of the following persons:-

J W Baxter, J Carlton, F J Coxe, G Day, S Gray, A G Halls, A B Jacobs, B Pearson, S J Starling, E J Watking, and G Wilson.

On a show of hands being taken the number of votes for each person was as follows:

Baxter 43, Carlton 6, Coxe 17, Day 14, Gray 38, Halls 49, Jacobs 36, Pearson 44, Starling 36, Watking 4, Wilson 16.

The Chairman subject to a demand for a poll declared the 7 highest duly elected.

A poll was demanded by the following persons:- W Wilson, E J Robinson, E B Carlton, W Wilkin, J Carlton, and G Wilson. and as the number exceeded the number required to demand a poll the Chairman declared that a poll must be held.
