It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson  
seconded by C Day that Mr Butler be  
reappointed caretaker of Parish Council Room

It was resolved on the proposition of S Eay seconded  
by G Wilson that the Clerk see J Day and  
<sup>offer</sup> ~~offer~~ the position of caretaker of War Memorial  
at the salary of 30/- per annum.

It was agreed on the proposition of S Eay seconded  
by C Day that the vacant road of allotment's

be let to J Boulton and V Smith  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  a rood each.

It was agreed that on the proposition of G Wilson  
 seconded by S Baof that A J Dutcher age  
 of 10/- for repairs to village pump be paid  
 and that A J Dutcher be instructed to  
 put the pump in thorough repair.

The resignation of W G Hobbs Esq as Treasurer of  
 the Council was received and on the proposition  
 of G Wilson seconded by S Baof it was  
 resolved that the Clerk send a letter of  
 thanks to him for his services

It was resolved on the proposition of G Wilson  
 seconded by S Baof that Mr G D C Hill  
 be appointed Treasurer in the place of  
 Mr Hobbs.
