

At a Parish Council meeting held on Nov 28<sup>th</sup> 1923 the following members were present Messrs G Wilson A G Hall C Day and B Fearson

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed.

In the absence of the Chairman and vice-chairman it was agreed that Mr G Wilson act as Chairman

A letter was read from the Chesterton Rural District Council enclosing a list of applicants for to hire a vacant council house.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Fearson seconded by C Day that G Hopkins be recommended as a tenant for the house.

A cheque was drawn in favour of H Fallantine for a sum of £7. 17. 0 being payment of half-year allotment rent due Sept 29<sup>th</sup> 1923 and a cheque was drawn in favour of G.H. Fearson for the sum of £5 for Petty Cash a/c

The clerk made a statement at the request of Mr J Bunnett regarding the provision of a well at the Council houses. After some discussion it was agreed that the matter be deferred till the next meeting as, three members of the Parish Council being absent it was thought unfair to come to any decision on the matter.
