

The Annual Parish Council meeting was held on April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1924

Present: Mr A D Jacobs & Wilson, C Day, S J Starling, B Pearson, S Baof and A L Halls

On the proposition of C Day seconded by B Pearson it was agreed that A D Jacobs be reappointed chairman for the ensuing year

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S J Starling that S Baof be vice-chairman.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A L Halls that Messrs D Wilson and J W Goodin be reappointed Overseers of the Poor.

It was resolved on the proposition of S Baof seconded by L Wilson that B Shipp be reappointed waterman at the same salary

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by C Day that Mrs Butler be reappointed caretaker of the Parish Room on the understanding that she undertakes to scrub the room at least 2 times during the year

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by C Day that the Council Room Committee be reappointed viz Messrs L Wilson and S Baof.

It was resolved on the proposition of R Pearson seconded by S J Starling that J Day be reappointed caretaker of the Memorial at the same salary viz £1-10-0 per annum

It was agreed that an allotments Committee be appointed and that the following should be appointed <sup>to act</sup> Messrs C Day R Pearson and S J Starling and it was agreed on the proposition of G Wilson seconded by S Bay that the allotments committee should also act as the Memorial committee.

It was agreed on the proposition of R Pearson seconded by A G Halls that the tax demanded on the Bank <sup>land</sup> ~~land~~ <sup>be</sup> should be paid as there appeared to be no way in which the Council could claim exemption

It was resolved on the proposition of G Wilson seconded by S Bay that a Butcher's apron for repairs to the village pump be paid.

A cheque was drawn amounting to £7.17.0 in payment of allotments rent due to Cambs County Council for Half-year ending March 25<sup>th</sup> 1924.

A cheque was also passed and signed in favour of R Pearson for £5- for Petty Cash
