

A Parish Council meeting held on Sept 5th 1924

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved and signed by the Chairman

A letter was read from the Cheltenham Rural District Council re the water supply at the Council houses and asking whether the Parish Council were willing to contribute to the cost of a well under the new conditions viz:-that the well be placed on the CRDC property instead of the opposite side of the road as agreed at a former meeting.

It was resolved on the proposition of S Bay seconded by G Wilson that the Parish Council contribute 50% of the cost of sinking a well on the condition that 4 houses at the cheaper rent be erected by the District Council.

The Clerk reported that H Wilkin wished to give up his allotment of 1 acre. It was agreed to take over the land at Sept 29th and the Clerk was instructed to ask R Starling to give up his land and to advertise the two acres to let and invite applications for the hire of the same.
