

The first meeting of the newly elected Jewish Council was held on April 17<sup>th</sup> 1925 when the following gentlemen were present. Messrs A D Jacobs B Pearson S Bay C Day A G Hall J W Darter and S J Starling.

Declarations of acceptance of office were signed by the councillors present.

It was resolved on the proposition of C Day sec. by B Pearson that Mr A D Jacobs be the Chairman of the Council and on the proposition of A G Hall seconded by C Day that Mr S Bay be the vice Chairman of the Council.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and passed as correct by the Council and signed by the Chairman.

A letter was produced and read by the Clerk containing the conditions under which the Council agreed to be responsible for half the cost of a public well at the Council houses. It was proposed by B Pearson, seconded by S Bay and carried that the letter be signed by the Chairman on behalf of the Council and forwarded by the Clerk to the Chesterton Rural District Council.

The following were appointed to serve as Trustees of the Jewish Charities for a term of 3 years. Mr B Pearson, Mr S Bay, S J Starling, and A G Hall.

The following were appointed to the Allotments and Memorial Committee:- Mr C Day Mr B Pearson and Mr S Eoof.

The following were appointed as Council Room Committee Mr S Eoof Mr B Pearson.

It was agreed that Mr H Wilson & Mr J W Goodin be reappointed Overseers of the Park.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson see by C Day that Mrs Butler be reappointed caretaker of Council Room.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson see by S E that B Shipp be reappointed waterman at the same salary viz:- 1/6 per week.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson see by S Eoof that John W Day be reappointed caretaker of the Memorial at the same salary viz:- £1.10.0 per annum.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson see by A G Halls that the Clerk write to Mrs Mills, the owner of a field known as Cherry Close asking whether she would sell the same to the Parish Council for the purpose of a recreation ground for the Parish.

On a resolution passed by the Parish meeting instructing the Council to take steps to obtain a telephone for the service for the Parish it was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson

seconded by S Eany that the matter be adjourned to the next meeting and that in the meantime the Clerk to obtain particulars as to the cost of such service.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A G Hello that the Parish Council take steps to erect a seat or seats at some convenient places in the Parish and it was further agreed that the Allotments and Memorial Committee act in the matter and that they should ascertain the most convenient position and the cost of carrying out the suggestion reporting to the Council at their next meeting the result of their deliberations

It was agreed on the proposition of J S Baxter seconded by S Doy that the Clerk should write to the Surveyor of Highways of the C.R.D.C. calling his attention to the water flooding the path and road near Innon Farm and also to the bad state of the road in Chesterton Fen and asking him to give these matters his attention.
