It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by J Darter the Overseers be instructed to take proceedings against G Branch for the recovery of arrears of rates.

A Parish Council meeting was held on October 2nd 1925 the following members being present Chairman Mr A B Jacobs Mrs J W Darter J J Starling S Eay G Day and A G Hall.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

It was agreed that the Clerk write to Mr C R Alder asking whether he would be willing to give up the field known as Pound Piece should the Council decide to proceed with the project of acquiring the field as a recreation ground for the parish.

It was agreed that the tenant of S Sharpe's land be required to pay £1 as compensation for crop left and unexhausted improvements.

It was resolved on the proposition of S Easy seconded by C Day the new tenants of H Divers land be given 3% per rood as compensation for the rough state in which the land was left.

It was resolved on the proposition of S J Starling seconded by A L Halls that H Divers acre of land be let to E Butler $\frac{1}{2}$ an acre to W Syrell $\frac{1}{2}$ of an acre and C Howard $\frac{1}{2}$ acre.

It was resolved on the proposition of S Easy seconded S J Starling that the Clerk write to the Surveyor calling his attention to the heaps of soil on the roadside in Butts Lane and asking for their removal.

The Clerk was instructed on the proposition of S J Starling seconded by C Day that to request A J Butcher to carry out repairs to the parish pumps.
