

At a Parish Council meeting on "February 9"
1926 the following members were present:-

The minutes of the previous meeting were read
by the Clerk and being approved were signed
by the Chairman

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson
seconded by S J Starling that J. H. Scarle
B Shipp G. J. Froment and Arthur Townsend
be nominated as constables for the
ensuing year.

A letter was received from the Clerk to the
Guardians stating that it was proposed to
take out a Guarantee Bond for the whole of the
Officers of the Guardians including the Acol Overseers
and Clerks to Parish Councils.

Under this scheme the premium for the Bond
of the Acol Overseers for the Parish of Milton
would amount to 30/- per annum and it
is suggested by the Guardians that the various
Committees should increase the salary of the
Acol Overseers by the amount of the premium
on the Bond.

On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by
C. Day it was agreed that the Clerk write
for further information before taking any action
in the matter
