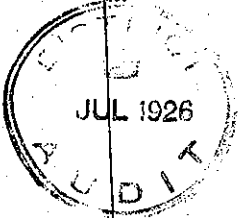

Annual meeting of Parish Council held on April 21st 1926

Present Mr A B Jacobs the Chairman Messrs J W Baxter S J Starling B Pearson C Day A G Halls and S Bayly

On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S J Starling Mr A B Jacobs was re-elected Chairman for year.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and after approval were signed by the Chairman.

On the proposition of A G Halls seconded by C Day Mr S Bayly was re-elected as vice Chairman for year.

It was resolved on the proposition of C Day that J W Gordon be one Overseer and on the proposition of C Day seconded by S Bayly that J W Baxter be the other Overseer.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by C Day that B Shipp be reappointed Waterman

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S J Starling that Mrs Butler be reappointed caretaker of Parish Council Room

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A G Halls that J Day be reappointed caretaker of the Memorial

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Bayl that one pound of lawn seed be purchased and sown in the turf round the Memorial to renovate the pasture

After a letter had been read from the Clerk to the Guardians containing answers to certain questions asked by the Council on the matter of the Bond of the Assistant Overseer it was resolved on the proposition of S Bayl seconded by A G Halls that the salary of the Assistant Overseer be raised by the sum £1-10-0 per annum from April 1st 1926

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Bayl that G Halls be recommended as a tenant for a vacant Council house
