

Parish Council meeting held on ~~July~~ June 3rd 1926 the following Councillors being present Mr A B Jacobs, Chairman, Messrs B Pearson a G Hall, S J Starling S Gray and C Day. J W Baxter.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk approved by the Council and signed by the Chairman.

A letter was read from the Chesterton Rural District Council informing the Parish Council that it was their intention to building two more houses and asked the Council for suggestions as to suitable sites for their erection. On the proposition of B Pearson it was agreed that a piece of land on the Cambridge Road owned by Mr A E Robinson be recommended as a suitable site. The Clerk was instructed to ask the District Council to purchase land sufficient for more than two houses as ~~so~~ such a large number of applicants for houses are still unsatisfied.

A request was received from the Housing Committee of the C R D C that the Parish Council should recommend 6 of the applicants for houses, whom, in their opinion were most in need of houses. After considerable discussion the following were recommended:-

George Black, John Shipp, Isaac Colborn, Stacey Cox, Mrs King & J G Butler, with C A Wayman as next in need.
