A Jewish Council meeting was held on March 2nd 1927 the following members being present. Mr S Easy vice chairman in the chair Messrs B Pearson S J Starling J W Baxter A G Hall & C Day.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk approved by the Council and signed by the Chairman

The following were nominated as constables for the ensuing year J. H. Searle B Shipp G T Fromont and A Townsend.

It was agreed that Mr B Pearson & Mr J W Baxter act as Parochial Representatives on the Assessment Committee of the Chesterton Rural District Council as required by the Rating Act 1926.

On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S J Starling it was resolved that the rent of the Gravel Pits occupied by Mr H Love be reduced from £1-10-0 to £1-0-0 per annum as from Sept 30th 1926

A letter was read from the G.R.D.C asking for precepts to be sent in by March 12th next, should any contribution from rates be required for Jewish Council expenses during the next half-year. After some consideration it was agreed that no precept be sent in as the Overseers could furnish the necessary funds for the coming half-year.

It was agreed on the proposition of S. B. that the fence adjoining the Fox Road on the Bank be repaired and that Mr. Abraham of Sandbeach be asked to do the work.

It was agreed that the Annual Jewish meeting be held on March 23rd and that notice should be given by the Clerk that at that meeting the provision of a recreation ground for the Jewish should be considered.
