

A special Parish Council meeting was held in the schoolroom on November 18<sup>th</sup> 1927 32 electors being present.

The meeting was called for the purpose of obtaining the views of the electors as to whether the Parish Council should proceed with the provision of a recreation ground, or having regard to the expenses that might be incurred in doing so, should cancel any further steps in the matter.

In the absence of the Chairman of the Council (Mr A B Jacobs) it was proposed by Mr Pearson seconded by Mr C Nichols that the Rev C S Phillips be Chairman. This was carried unanimously.

The Chairman asked the Clerk to make a statement to the meeting as to what had been done by the Parish Council in regard to the provision of a recreation ground.

Mr B Pearson in a speech pointing out the necessity of a recreation ground for the Parish formally proposed "That the Parish Council be empowered to take the necessary steps to obtain a recreation ground for the Parish." This was seconded by Mr J Bradnam.

On a vote being taken there voted:-

For the motion 11 Against 15.

The Chairman therefore declared the motion lost.

A counter proposal was made by Mr J Garner seconded by Mr J Love "That the Parish Council be requested to enter into negotiations for the purchase of a field known as Kuech's Close for the use of the Parish for ever providing this can be done at a moderate price"

On a vote being taken there voted for the motion 15 against 10.

The Chairman therefore declared the motion duly carried

At a Parish Council meeting held on Dec 16<sup>th</sup> 1927 the following members were present  
Mr A B Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs J W Baxter  
B Pearson and A G Halls.

The minutes of previous meeting were read by the Clerk approved by the Council and signed by the Chairman

It was agreed that the Clerk fill in and return the forms as to soft roads in the Parish, required by the County Council.

The minutes of the special Parish meeting called for the purpose of obtaining the views of the electors regarding a recreation ground were read and it was resolved on the proposition of J W Baxter seconded by A G Halls that the Clerk write to the owners of Kuech's Close enquiring whether they were will to sell or let the field to <sup>the</sup> Parish Council as a recreation ground
