

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on January 13th 1928 the following members were present Mr A B Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs C Day, A G Halls, D Pearson J W Baxter and S Easy

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk approved by the Council and signed by the Chairman

A letter was read from the owners of Beech's Close suggesting that the Council should purchase the whole of the property and then retain the field for the purposes required. After some discussion it was proposed by D Pearson seconded by S Easy that no further action be taken in the matter. This proposal obtained no further support so was therefore lost.

It was then proposed by A G Halls seconded by J W Baxter that the owners of Beech's Close be approached with an enquiry as to the lowest price that would be accepted for the grass field and corrugated iron shed thereon. This proposal was carried

It was resolved on the proposition of S Easy seconded by J W Baxter that the Clerk write to the Surveyor of the C R D C calling his attention to the drain leading from the pond down Den Road and asking him to take steps to clear the drain which appeared to be blocked
