

It was resolved on the proposition of J. H. Darter seconded by G. Day that he clerk write to the Housing Committee of C.R.D.C. asking them to build more houses in the village and to suggest that houses be built which can be purchased by the tenants on the instalment plan, there being no burden on the rates.

The clerk was instructed to write to the C.R.D.C. expressing the dissatisfaction of the Council at the way in which the work on the drain had been leading from the pond down Iron Road had been done and also to protest at the delay in attending to the public well.

It was agreed that no other business be taken at the Parish meeting of March 12<sup>th</sup> other than the election of a Parish Council.
