

The first meeting of the newly elected Parish Council was held on April 20th 1928

Present B Pearson C Day, A G Halls S Bayl
A J Butcher and A B Jacobs

Declarations of acceptance of office were signed by the councillors present

On the proposition of C Day seconded by A G Halls it was resolved that A B Jacobs be Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by C Day that S Bayl be vice chairman

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Bayl that Mr Butler be reappointed caretaker of Parish Council Room

It was resolved on the proposition of A G Halls seconded by A J Butcher that B Shipps be reappointed waterman.

The appointment of 4 Trustees to the Charities was postponed till the next meeting.

It was resolved on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A J Butcher that the clerk be instructed to write a strong letter to the Chesterton Rural District Council drawing their

attention to the state of the village pond and suggesting that the cheapest and best cure for the trouble would be to fill it up.

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on July 20th 1928 the following members were present. Mr A B Jacobs, Chairman, Messrs B Pearson J W Porter, S Bay, and A J Butcher.

The minutes of previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

The following gentlemen were appointed as representative Trustees of the Milton Parochial Charities for a term of three years from April 15th 1928:-

Mr E J Walkling, Mr B Pearson, Mr A Hall and Mr E Cooper.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Bay that J Day be appointed caretaker of the War Memorial at the same salary viz: £1-10-0 per annum.

A letter was received from N S Chalk of Cambridge the value appointed to value Recch's Close as a village playground which stated that in his opinion the value of the land was £250.

After some discussion it was proposed by B Pearson seconded by A J Butcher.
