

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on November 9th 1928 the following members were present Mr A B Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs S Baof A I Butcher, A G Halls, and B Pearson.

The minutes of the meeting of July 20th 1928 were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by A I Butcher it was agreed that the acre of allotment vacated by Bert Shipp be let to G Unwin.

On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by S Baof it was resolved that a sum of £2 0.0 (Two pounds) per annum be charged to the allotments account as being the portion of the clerks salary necessary to defray the expenses of rent collection and management of the allotments.
