It was agreed on the proposition of A J Butcher seconded by S Easy that the Clerk write to ^{the} owners of Neech's Close asking what rent they would require to let the close to the Parish Council, for a playing ground.

It was agreed on the proposition of S Easy seconded by J W Barter that the Clerk write to the Surveyor of the CRDC drawing his attention to the bad state of the Histon and Fen roads and asking him to repair the same at the earliest possible moment.

The Clerk was also instructed to write to the owners of Bristwoods garden calling their attention to the dangerous condition of the hedge adjoining Butts Lane and asking them to prune the hedge as soon as possible.

It was agreed that ~~the~~ on the proposition of A J Butcher seconded by S Eddy that the Clerk write to the Sanitary Committee of the C R D C enquiring as to what steps (if any) had been taken towards filling up the pond.

On the proposition of B Geanson seconded by A J Butcher it was agreed that the Clerk be instructed to write to Messrs Rattee & Kett asking for an estimate as to the cost of inscribing the name of H Head on the War Memorial
