

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on March 1<sup>st</sup> 1929 the following members were present Mr A D Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs J W Baxter, S Bay, A F Dutcher & C Day

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman

A letter was read from the owners of Neech's Close offering to let the close for the sum of £15 per annum.

After some discussion it was agreed on the proposition of S Bay seconded by J W Baxter that the Council make an offer of Ten pounds (£10) per annum for the close.

A letter was read from Messrs Rattee & Kettle of Cambridge offering to inscribe the name of H Inead on the War Memorial at an inclusive charge of 14/6

As this was considered reasonable it was agreed that the offer be accepted and that the work be done as soon as the weather became suitable

The estimates for the ensuing year were considered and it was agreed to issue precepts on the Blestiston Rural Council for the sum of Twenty Pounds (£20).

It was agreed that the annual Parish meeting should be held on March 29<sup>th</sup> next
