

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on August 9th 1929 the following members were present Mr S Easy (Chairman) Messrs A B Jacobs, J W Barter and A J Butcher.

On the proposition of J W Barter seconded by A J Butcher, that the Clerk write to the Surveyor of the Cheltenham Rural Council drawing his attention to the bad state of the watercourses in the Town, together with a dangerous gutter in Fox Road and asking him to remedy these matters as soon as possible.

It was resolved on the proposition of A B Jacobs seconded by A J Butcher, that the village green committee be given power to go to any reasonable expense in repairing the fence round the green.

The Clerk was instructed, on the proposition of A B Jacobs seconded by A J Butcher, to write to the advertising agents responsible, asking them to remove an advertising sign erected on the village green.

A letter was read from Mr B Pearson containing his intention of resigning from the Council. On the proposition of A B Jacobs seconded by A J Butcher the Clerk was instructed to write to Mr B Pearson accepting his resignation with regret.
