A meeting of the Council was held January 8th 1930 the following members being present:-

The minutes of the meeting of October 23rd were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

The report of the village green committee was given by Mr J Darter who stated that the work of repairing the fence was ~~is~~ being pushed forward and it was intended to root up the elm suckers and clear up the ground generally. It was agreed that the committee should obtain chestnut trees to plant round the field and each member of the Council undertook to defray the cost of one tree.

A circular letter was received from the Chesterton Rural Council enquiring whether the water supply of the village was

satisfactory. It was agreed on the proposition of A D Jacobs seconded by C Day that the Clerk be instructed to inform the Chesterton Rural Council that in the opinion of the Parish Council that taking into account the public and private artesian wells the water supply of the village was satisfactory.

A letter was read from the Town Planning Committee of the Borough of Cambridge stating that as a part of Milton came under the Town planning scheme, the committee would be glad to consider any observations the Council had to make on the matter.

It was agreed on the proposition of A D Jacobs seconded by A F Dutcher that the Clerk be instructed to acknowledge the letter and inform the committee that the Council have no observations to make on the matter.

It was agreed on the proposition of the Chairman seconded by A D Jacobs that the Clerk write to the Cambridge Gas Co. asking them to extend the supply of gas to the Parish.

There being a vacancy on the Council the following were nominated to fill the vacancy Mr L C Nichols proposed by J W Baxter
Mr French proposed by Mr S Eady
A ballot was taken, when Mr Nichols received 4 votes and Mr French 2 votes
Mr Nichols was therefore declared duly elected
