

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on August 1st 1930 the following members were present Mr S Eason (Chairman) Messrs A I Butcher L C Nichols and A B Jacobs

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

A letter was read from the Chesterton Rural Council offering to defray one half the cost of filling in the pond if the Parish Council would be responsible for the other half.

It was resolved on the proposition of A B Jacobs seconded by L C Nichols that the Clerk be instructed to inform the Rural Council that the Parish Council accepted no responsibility for the condition of the pond nor for the filling it in.

It was resolved on the proposition of A I Butcher seconded by L C Nichols that the Clerk be instructed to write to Messrs A & B Hall of Ely asking them if they would remove the post in the centre of the path in front of Mrs Todd's shop, as it was very dangerous to pedestrians on dark nights. S Eason
