

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on February 10th 1931 the following members were present Mr S Eason Chairman, Messrs A G Hall & C Nichol C Day A B Jacobs and A I Butcher.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

A letter was read from Messrs Thurston & Son making an offer of £8 for the use of the village green for the annual feast from May 10th to May 17th inclusive. On the proposition of A G Hall seconded by C Nichol it was agreed that the offer be accepted.

It was agreed that the clerk should send the letter received from the Ministry of Health concerning Dr Woodman's roadway to Mr A Taburn for his further information on the matter.

It was resolved on the proposition of A G Hall seconded by A I Butcher that the following names be submitted as constables for the ensuing year

It was agreed that the Clerk write to the Electric Light company enquiring whether there was a likelihood of a supply being extended to Milton in the near future.

It was agreed on the proposition of A G Hall seconded by J C Nichols that the Clerk inspect the sluices on the bank side of Raitobite and report thereon at the next meeting. J Easy

A meeting for the election of Parish councillors was held in the schoolroom on March 9th 1931. 7 electors present. On the proposition of B Pearson seconded by J Easy G.H. Pearson was voted to the Chair.

The chair was taken at 7.43 pm.
