

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on May 6th 1931 the following members were present :- Mr A B Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs E J Walkling I C Richards S Eason C Day B Pearson and A J Butcher

On the question of filling in the pond Mr B Pearson offered to provide the horses and carts free if the Council agreed to pay the wages of the men required to do the work.

It was resolved on the proposition of E J Walkling seconded by I C Richards that Mr B Pearson's offer be accepted and that the thanks of the Council be tendered to Mr B Pearson for his generous offer.

It was resolved on the proposition of E J Walkling seconded by S Eason that the Clerk be authorised to purchase traps of the Parish providing the cost does not exceed 1⁰/₂.

The question of a water supply for the Parish was adjourned till the next meeting

It was resolved on the proposition of C Day seconded by B Pearson that Mr S Eason be reappointed School Manager for a term of 3 years and that a letter of protest be sent to the Council

Education Secretary pointing out that meetings of Managers are held with very long intervals between the meetings, which practice in the opinion of the Council is neither a business-like ~~or~~ desirable way to conduct the affairs of the school.

A cheque was drawn in favour of the County Agricultural Officer value £4-14-0 in payment of allotments rent due March 25th 1931.
