

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on July 9<sup>th</sup> 1931 the following were present: - Mr A B Jacobs (Chairman) Messrs S Easy, J C Nichols, B Pearson, C Day and A J Butcher.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and being approved were signed by the Chairman.

The accounts of the Parish Council for the year ending March 31<sup>st</sup> 1931 were read and on the proposition of S Easy seconded by A J Butcher it was agreed that the Chairman sign the a/c's in readiness for audit.

A letter was read from the Milton Women's Institute asking the Council to consider the question of lighting the streets by electricity when the supply should be available.

It was agreed on the proposition of B Pearson seconded by J C Nichols that the Clerk be instructed to enquire what the cost of the provision of lights is likely to be when further consideration can be given to the matter.

It was agreed on the proposition of S Easy seconded by J C Nichols that 3 seats be purchased at once and placed on the site of the Pond, for the use of the

public and Mr Jacobs and Mr Pearson were appointed to obtain suitable seats and given authority to purchase at their discretion.

The clerk was instructed to post notices in the parish advertising the vacancy of the post of clerk to the Council and asking for applications to be sent in not later than July 23<sup>rd</sup>.
