

A Parish Council Meeting

It was proposed by Mr. Easy seconded
by Mr. Woodman that a letter be sent
to Mr. G. Pearson re Electric light.

Proposed by Mr. Baker sec. by Mr. Woodman
that Mrs. Thurston's offer be accepted
for the coming year in May and also
that a deposit of £2 (Two Pounds) be
asked for. If she wishes to stay a
little longer it can be arranged
but she must clear up the ground,
also that a letter of regret be sent

Proposed by Mr. Garner sec. by Mr. Easy that Messrs Woodman, Baxter & Wilkin be appointed Allotment Sub-committee

Proposed by J. Woodman sec. by Mr. Easy that Mr. Kidman be further asked to produce his Allotment Agreement, also that a Registered letter be sent to Mr. Geo. Urwin asking him to pay the Allotment rent owing to the Council in 8 days or they will have to put the matter in other hands with a Claim for dilapidation.

If Mr. Kidman's Agreement is on 12 months rent free conditions, the Council will accept the same. Also that Mr. Harriell Cox be asked to pay her overdue rent.
