A Parish Council Mtg. was held in the Parish Room on Sept. 10th., 1935, at 7.30 p.m.

Present: - Mr. G. S. French (V.-Chairman) in the Chair, Messrs Garner & Wilkin, & Dr. R. M. Woodman.

The Minutes of the previous Mtg. were read, confirmed, & signed.

A letter was read from the Chairman in which he conveyed his resignation. On the proposal of Mr. Garner seconded by Mr. French this was accepted. A resolution expressing thanks for past services was passed, & his hope expressed that Mr. Wuckworth would not sever all connections, but would remain a Councillor.

Mr. Garner proposed & Mr. Wilkin seconded that an advertisement for a Clerk be issued. Carried.

Mr. Garner proposed & Mr. Wilkin seconded that Mr. G. S. French be appointed Chairman. Carried.

On the proposition of Dr. Woodman seconded by Mr. French, Mr. Garner was elected to the vacant position of Cheque-signer.

At the Mtg. which lasted one hour was closed by declaration of the Chairman.

The following resolution, proposed by Dr. Woodman, & seconded by Mr. Garner, was carried unanimously: "That, acting solely on the wishes of the people as expressed in the answer to a referendum of the village, the Ulton Parish Council

decided not to oppose the Chesterton
R.D.C. if this body ^{desired} wished to link
up Millar with Comfau's water."
The Meeting, which lasted an
hour, was then closed.
