It was proposed by Mr. Bay, seconded by Mr. Wickin that a letter be sent to the Lekeston R. D. C. to the effect that we require 4 Hydrants. Carried.

It was proposed by Mr. Bay, seconded by Mr. J. Garner that Mr. J. W. Hill be appointed clerk to the Parish Council. Carried.

The Meeting which lasted 1 hour was then closed.
