AT 8.10 p.m. a SHOW OF HANDS WAS TAKEN by the Chairman, &, as there was no demand for a poll, he declared the following as to be Parish Councillors: Messrs D.H. Easy, F.M. Garner, B.E. Lander, E.J. Walkling, F. Wilson, C.P. Winckworth, & Dr R.M. Woodman.

THE MINUTES of the previous Parish Meeting were read, confirmed by the Meeting, & signed by the Chairman.

THE audited PARISH ACCOUNTS for the year ending Mar. 31st, 1936, were ADOPTED by the Meeting on the proposition of Mr F.M. Garner seconded by Mr Wilkin. A suggestion brought forward by Mr G.H.Pearson that seats should be provided at the 'bus stop near the Institute, Hear the recreation ground or on it, & opposite the Council Houses, was promised sympathetic consideration by the Chairman of the Parish Council.

A vote of thanks to the presiding Chairman was carried unanimously.

The Meeting, which lasted until 9.20 p.m., was then closed by declaration of the Chairman.
