

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD IN THE
SCHOOLROOM ON TUESDAY THE 29TH MARCH 1938.

There were present:-

1. THE MINUTES of the previous Parish Meeting were read, confirmed by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.
2. THE ACCOUNTS of the Parish Council for the year ended 31st March 1937 were presented and it was proposed by Mr. H. Meech and seconded by Mr. W. C. Mead "That this Meeting adopts the accounts of the Parish Council". This was carried unanimously.
3. THE ACCOUNTS of the Milton Charity Trustees were then presented by the Clerk of that body and on the proposition of Mr. Walkling seconded by Mr. Mead these were adopted by the Meeting. The Chairman proposed a vote of thanks to the Clerk of the Charity Trustees for his attendance and this was seconded by Mr. Walkling and carried unanimously.
4. Mr. Lander proposed and Mr. W. Halls seconded that - "The County Surveyor be asked if the drain pipes proposed for alterations could not be used on the length of drain from the centre of the village and along the Fen Road, instead of for the length from Butt Lane to the centre of the village as proposed and that the reasons of the Meeting for the change be given".

The Meeting was declared closed at 8 p.m. by the Chairman.
