

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL  
MEETING HELD IN THE PARISH ROOM ON TUESDAY, 25TH  
APRIL, 1939, AT 7.30 P.M.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

It was proposed by Mr. E. J. Walkling and seconded  
by Mr. C. P. T. Winckworth "That Dr. R. M. Woodman be  
re-elected Chairman of the Parish Council for the ensuing  
twelve months". The resolution was put to the meeting by  
Mr. F. Wilson and carried unanimously.

MINUTES.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were taken as  
read and were signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES.

The Chairman reported that he had communicated with  
the County Council concerning the dead tree on the edge of  
the path between Mr. Winckworth's and Mr. E. Halls' property  
and the matter was receiving their attention.

APPOINTMENT OF VICE-CHAIRMAN.

It was proposed by Mr. C. P. T. Winckworth and  
seconded by Mr. F. M. Garner "That Mr. E. J. Walkling be  
appointed Vice-Chairman for the year. Carried unanimously.

SUPPLY OF GAS TO MILTON.

The question of a supply of gas being brought to  
Milton was discussed and on the proposition of Mr. E. J.  
Walkling and seconded by Mr. F. M. Garner the following  
resolution was carried unanimously - "That the Parish Council  
of Milton ask the Cambridge University and Town Gas Light  
Company to consider a supply of gas to Milton in the near  
future".

The Clerk reported that Mr. Harry Halls had hired the rood of allotments vacated by Mr. R. Buck at a rental of 7s. 8d. per annum.

An application was received from Miss. N. C. Honey for permission to erect a tent and to build a fire in the Recreation Ground during Guide Week, 8th-15th May, 1939. Mr. D. H. Easy proposed and Mr. F. Wilson seconded "That the necessary permission be granted". This was carried unanimously.

A complaint regarding the fence at the edge of the ditch in Fen Road just beyond the school was considered and on the proposition of Mr. F. M. Garner, seconded by Mr. F. Wilson it was resolved to draw this matter to the attention of the Surveyor to Chesterton Rural District Council.

Mr. E. J. Walkling raised the question of the lack of fire fighting apparatus in the village and it was proposed by Mr. B. E. Lander, seconded by Mr. E. J. Walkling and carried unanimously "That the Chesterton Rural District Council be asked to consider this in the light of the Fire Brigades Act, 1938, and that the matter be expedited."

The Clerk reported that the Parish Council Notice Board required repainting and he was instructed to arrange for the necessary work to be executed.

The Clerk reported that he had received information to the effect that when the fence bounding Milton Hall property was re-erected it was brought forward some distance on to the grass verge. Mr. F. M. Garner proposed and Mr. B. E. Lander seconded "That the County Surveyor be asked to investigate".

It was decided to invite tenders for the hire of the feed on the Recreation Ground for the period 16th May to 30th June inclusive and to leave the matter in the hands of the Chairman and Clerk.

The Meeting was declared closed at 7.55 p.m.
