

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

HELD IN THE PARISH ROOM ON TUESDAY THE

23RD APRIL 1940.

PRESENT:-

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

It was proposed by Mr. E. J. Walkling and  
seconded by Mr. D. H. Easy and carried unanimously -

"That Dr. R. M. Woodman be elected Chairman of  
the Parish Council for the ensuing year".

MINUTES.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were then  
read, confirmed by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.

APPOINTMENT OF VICE-CHAIRMAN.

It was proposed by Mr. E.J. Walkling and seconded  
by Mr. D. H. Easy "That Mr. F. Wilson be appointed  
Vice-Chairman".

An amendment "That Mr. E. J. Walkling be appointed  
Vice Chairman" was put forward by Mr. F. Wilson and seconded  
by Mr. F. M. Garner and on the amendment being put to the  
vote this was carried unanimously.

APPOINTMENT OF PARISH COUNCILLOR.

After considerable discussion it was proposed by  
Mr. F. M. Garner and seconded by Mr. E. J. Walkling "That  
the Reverend G. T. Berwick be invited to fill the casual  
vacancy on the Parish Council".

REPRESENTATIVE TO IMPINGTON VILLAGE COLLEGE MANAGING BODY.

Mr. F. M. Garner proposed "That Mr. E. J. Walkling  
continue as the Council's representative on the Managing  
Body of Impington Village College". This proposition was  
seconded by Mr. F. Wilson.

REPRESENTATIVE TO MILTON SCHOOL MANAGERS.

It was proposed by Mr. E. J. Walkling and seconded  
by Mr. F. Wilson "That Mr. F. Garner continue as the  
representative to Milton School Managers".

The Clerk also reported the receipt of two letters from the Cambridgeshire Rural Community Council regarding the disposal of surplus vegetables and Cambridgeshire Parish Councils Advisory Service. No action was taken in these matters.

The Clerk reported a complaint he had received from an allotment tenant regarding trespassing on the allotments, and whether the Council would erect a notice forbidding trespassing. After discussion it was agreed that no action be taken.

This concluded the business and the Chairman declared the meeting closed at 8.40 p.m.
